Pre-requisite: Registrants must have completed Practitioner Training

People who work with the Map are professional, qualified and thoughtful. Are you ready to take your work with the Map to the next level?

Develop and deepen your practise as you work towards becoming a Certified Practitioner through a structured program.

This five month guided process will enable you to:

- Clarify the way you want to develop and use the Map in your own particular professional setting.
- Practice using the Map in a range of ways: on yourself, with another and in relevant organisational, or at scale contexts.
- Have the support and inspiration of a small group of other self-directed learners as well as the founders of MOMI as facilitators,
- Have clear deliverables and a practical workbook to guide you.
- Have accountability structures to support you to build your certification portfolio.
- Prepare for the final certification interview and presentation.
- Build confidence and experience using the Map of Meaning® in your work or business so as to maximise your investment in becoming a trained practitioner of the Map of Meaning®.

Time commitment over 18 weeks

- 10h whole group Live Zoom meetings (Five x two hour sessions)
- Min of 7.5h small group meetings. We recommend 5 x 1h30 sessions but each small group can choose to meet more often if needed
- Between 2-4h a week practice time
- 6–10h creating portfolio and preparing for certification interview.

Note: This program prepares you well for the certification Interview but does not guarantee certification. If we feel that a practitioner is not yet ready for certification, we will provide clear feedback and guidance regarding how gaps can be bridged.
